Year of inception: 2007

Contra Costa

Student athletes: 300
Participating schools: 32 classrooms, representing 17 schools
Sports offered: track & field; soccer (fall '08); basketball (winter '09)
Year of inception: 2007 (pilot)

Clark County, Nevada

Student athletes: 2,305 athletes plus 759 partners
Participating schools: all elementary and secondary schools are eligible to participate
Sports offered: track & field, bowling, soccer, basketball, Ultimate Challenge (motor skills activity program for students with severe and profound disabilities)
Year of inception: 2003

*The Nevada School Partnership Program teams disabled students with non-disabled partners. Clark County is the fifth largest school district and practices full-inclusion. Ultimate Challenge is not full inclusion but provides services to district students physically unable to participate at the Unified level.
